ADHD Evals – For those with insurance, the first suggestion is to call the 800 number on the AHCCCS card (for behavioral health) and ask if they have any providers that can do an ADHD evaluation. **It is an idea to contact a school psychologist (every school will have one) and see if they do evaluations on the side. ASU Resources: ASU Counseling’s Community Link (vetted mental health and other health providers – it is a great resource!)
