Students must meet all qualifications (e.g., all grades in-progress posted, transcript received, overall cumulative GPA 3.25+) to qualify for the Honors Achievement Award. Official copies of **ALL** transcripts must be on file with the college.

Honors Achievement Award Application



The Honors Program offers talented and motivated students opportunities for extended academic and personal growth through many special courses that emphasize critical thinking, verbal expressions, and creative problem solving.

Honors experiences are offered in many disciplines and satisfy the general education requirements for graduation. Most courses will transfer to four-year colleges and universities. Honors courses are indicated as such on transcripts.

Students who complete a minimum of 15 Honors credits under four (4) different prefixes (Pass/Fail credits excluded), whose cumulative grade-point average is 3.500 or higher, and who meet all college specific requirements will be designated as **Honors Program Graduates** upon graduation.

Honor Program Graduates are encouraged to apply for honors programs and scholarships at state universities and other institutions.

Eligible Students

Students who have accumulated a minimum of 12 credits in courses numbered 100 and above (Pass/Fail (PZ) credits excluded) and who have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher may apply for the **Honors Achievement Award**. Students who are accepted will receive partial tuition/fee waivers based on the number of credits they complete in a given semester.

| Number of Credits | Amount of Award |
|-------------------|-----------------|
| 12 or more | \$325.00 |
| 9 - 11 | 244.00 |
| 6 - 8 | 163.00 |
| 3 - 5 | 81.00 |

All students submitting an Honors Achievement Award application must submit one of the following:

1. An Arizona driver license issued after 1996 or an Arizona non-operating identification license.
2. A birth certificate or delayed birth certificate issued in any state, territory or possession of the United States.
3. A United States certificate of birth abroad.
4. A United States passport.
5. A foreign passport with a United States visa.
6. An I-94 form with a photograph.
7. A United States citizenship and immigration services employment authorization document or refugee travel document.
8. A United States certificate of naturalization.
9. A United States certificate of citizenship.
10. A tribal certificate of Indian blood.
11. A tribal or bureau of Indian affairs affidavit of birth.
12. Tribal members, the elderly and "persons with disabilities or incapacity of the mind or body," may submit certain types of documentation under Section 1903 of the federal Social Security Act (42 United States Code §1396b, as amended by Section 6036 of the federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005). If you think that this may apply, please contact the Legal Services Department for assistance.

Students accepted into the Honors Achievement Award must meet the following requirements each semester:

Enroll in and complete with a grade of "C" or higher at least one honors course

Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher (cumulative GPA includes all Maricopa County Community College courses).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Honors Program students should not withdraw from courses or alter class schedules without approval of the Honors Program Office. Refund, drop-add, and withdrawal policies, dates, and deadlines apply to Honors Program Students.

Deadline for applying for the Honors Achievement Award is the Friday before the start of the fall or spring semester. The financial award is processed after grade verifications at the end of each semester, including a "C" or better in a 3 credit honors class.
