# Student Mathematics League Competition!

## What is it?

The **Student Mathematics League Competition** is two multiple-choice tests given to community college students all over the country.

**Round One will be Friday, October 29, 2010 at 1:00 pm in MA-124.**

Students have exactly one hour to work on the exam and may start the exam any time between 1:00 pm and 1:59 pm. (No student may leave the test room prior to 2:00 pm). The test includes questions from algebra, geometry, logic, and probability (no calculus). The questions are usually challenging in nature. Round 2 will be in March of next year.

- To prepare our students for the competition, we will hold practice sessions every Friday (starting October 1<sup>st</sup>) in room MA 124 from 1:00 to 2:00.

## Why should I?

The obvious answer is because it will look great on your resume. But there are other benefits. Nationally, the first place winner gets a scholarship of \$3000 to the college of her/his choice. At GCC, **the top participant in each round will win a graphing calculator**, provided they have not already won one. The three students who have the highest combined score for both rounds will win scholarships.

**First Place - \$500 scholarship**  
**Second Place - \$300 scholarship**  
**Third Place - \$200 scholarship**
