

Information Concerning a Crime in Progress

Campus safety programs require the cooperation and support of the campus community. All students, staff, and visitors are encouraged to become active participants by taking common sense precautions with their personal safety and the security of their property. Community members are encouraged to report any observation of a suspected crime, unusual or suspicious activity, or an emergency situation.

If you see what appears to be a crime in progress or some suspicious activity, e.g., someone hiding behind a vehicle, vehicles driving up and down the parking aisles when there are open parking spaces available, people loitering in the parking lots, someone sitting in a vehicle with the engine running, someone wandering around the inside of a building for no apparent reason, etc., please notify College Safety.

When in doubt, report it anyway, and the College Safety Department will dispatch an officer to investigate the situation.
