

Information Concerning Hazardous Material Accidents

The college complies with OSHA regulations pertaining to Hazardous Chemical/Material handling and the Bloodborne Pathogens Standards.

Incidents involving human blood will normally require the use of universal precautions and engineering implements (e.g., latex gloves, goggles, CPR mask, face protection, dust pan, etc.). Such use will protect the victim, the first aid provider, and the employee cleaning the contaminated surface. In the case of hazardous chemicals/materials, special protection equipment may be required.
