

WHAT TO DO

If a fire occurs in your area:

1. Put it out if it is a small, extinguishable fire and you are trained in the use of fire extinguishers. Otherwise, alert all occupants in your area of the situation.
2. Never allow the fire to come between you and the exit.
3. Notify College Safety (53535) if time allows. If not, evacuate promptly and pull the fire alarm as you exit the building. Watch for the responding officer and provide information.
4. Don't panic if trapped. Use the telephone to notify College Safety (53535) of your location.

DO NOT:

Use the elevator or break windows.

Return for personal belongings. You may not get a second chance to leave.
