Western Undergraduate Exchange Program**

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program is a student exchange program coordinated by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) and administered by the Arizona Board of Regents. Through WUE, students who reside in western states (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming) and meet the eligibility requirements, pay 150 percent of the regular resident tuition plus fees. Student must mark prominently on the Student Information Form, either online or on paper form, that they seek admission as a WUE student. WUE students will not be allowed to change their status once registration for classes has occurred.

WUE students who later want to establish residency will need to follow the criteria to do so. This will require the student to pay out-of-state tuition for one year following the completion of their WUE status. Student can choose to sit out, not take classes, the year they are establishing residency.
