Diversity of Enrollment

In Fall 2021 enrollment of all full-time undergraduate students in credit programs was 3654 .Of these 51% were female and 48% were male. 1% were American Indian/Alaska Native, 4% were Asian/Pacific Islander, 5% were Black, 43% were Hispanic, 38% were White, 5% were Two or More Races, and 2% were Non-Resident Alien.

Diversity of Pell Recipients

Federal Pell Grant recipients comprised 42% of the full-time enrolled students in Fall 2021. Of these, 58% were female and 40% were male. 71% of the Pell recipients identified themselves as members of a racial or ethnic minority.

Retention Rates

63.33% of the first-time, full-time undergraduate students who enrolled in Fall 2020 returned in Fall 2021. The part-time student retention rate was 42.44%.

Graduation and Transfer Rates

The 3-year graduation rate for full-time students entering in Fall 2021 was 16%. The 3-year transfer-out rate was 19%
