

Equity in Athletics Report-Glendale Community College

Academic year 2024-25

(Pursuant to 20 USC §1092(g))

I. Enrollment:

The college enrolled 1832 full-time male students and 1967 full-time female students. Of these students, 142 male students were on at least one intercollegiate athletic team, and 101 female students were on at least one intercollegiate athletic team.

II. Expenses:

The total expenses for all teams were \$649,047. The costs incurred for men's basketball were \$93,948. The expenses incurred for all other men's sports combined were \$245,825. The amount of expenses generated from women's basketball was \$104,071. The amount of expenses generated from all other women's sports combined was \$297,867.

III. Sports:

A. **Women's Basketball:** On this team, there were 19 participants. The total operating expenses were \$21,240. The head coach is a male and serves as a full-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one female; zero of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

B. **Women's Soccer:** On this team, there were 28 participants. The total operating expenses were \$23,389. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there are two assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, one is female; none of them are full-time and the others are part-time.

C. **Women's Cross Country:** On this team, there were 4 participants. The total operating expenses were \$2716. The head coach is a female and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

D. **Women's Softball:** On this team, there were 20 participants. The total operating expenses were \$12,252. The head coach is a female and serves as a full-time employee. Additionally, there are two assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, one is female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

E. **Women's Tennis:** This team had 7 participants. The total operating expenses were \$6266. The head coach is a male and a part-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. None of the assistant coaches is male; none are full-time, and the others are part-time. One is female; zero are full-time, and the others are part-time.

F. **Women's Volleyball:** On this team, there were 12 participants. The total operating expenses were \$9188. The head coach is a female and serves as a full-time employee. Additionally, there are two assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, one is female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

G. **Women's Indoor/Outdoor Track and Field:** On this team, there were 11 participants. The total operating expenses were \$22,277. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there are six assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, four are male;

none of them is full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, two are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

H. **Men's Basketball:** On this team, there were 17 participants. The total operating expenses were \$11,959. The head coach is a male and serves as a full-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, none are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

I. **Men's Baseball:** On this team, there were 42 participants. The total operating expenses were \$15,606. The head coach is a male and serves as a full-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, none are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

J. **Men's Golf:** On this team, there were 5 participants. The total operating expenses were \$7764. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there are zero assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, none are male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, none are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

K. **Men's Soccer:** On this team, there were 37 participants. The total operating expenses were \$12,164. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there are three assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, two are male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, one is a female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

L. **Men's Cross Country:** On this team, there were 8 participants. The total operating expenses were \$1732. The head coach is a female and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, one is male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, none are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

M. **Men's Tennis:** On this team, there were 5 participants. The total operating expenses were \$2826. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there is one assistant coach for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, none are male; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, one is female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

N. **Men's Indoor/Outdoor Track and Field:** On this team, there were 28 participants. The total operating expenses were \$10,075. The head coach is a male and serves as a part-time employee. Additionally, there are three assistant coaches for this sport. Among the assistant coaches, three are male; none of them is full-time, and the others are part-time. Among the assistant coaches, none are female; none of them are full-time, and the others are part-time.

IV. Student Aid:

The college spent a total amount of \$121,712 on athletically related student aid, including the value of waivers. Of this amount, \$47,971 was spent on aid for men's teams and \$73,741 was spent on aid for women's teams. The ratio of athletically related aid awarded to male athletes to that awarded to female athletes was 39 to 61.

V. Recruiting:

The college spent a total amount of \$0 on recruiting. Of this amount, \$0 was spent on recruiting for men's teams and \$0 was spent on recruiting for women's teams.

VI. Salaries:

The average salary of head coaches for men's teams was \$14,699. The average salary of head coaches for women's teams was \$16,290. The average salary of assistant coaches for men's teams was \$1776. The average salary of assistant coaches for women's teams was \$1973.

VII. Revenues:

The amount of total revenue generated for all teams was \$741,711. Of this amount, the amount of revenues generated for men's teams was \$339,773, and the amount of revenues generated for women's teams was \$401,938. The amount of revenue generated from men's basketball was \$93,948. The amount of revenues generated from all other men's sports combined was \$245,825. The amount of revenue generated from women's basketball was \$104,071. The amount of revenues generated from all other women's sports combined was \$297,867.
