

# How to Use [maricopa.edready.org](https://maricopa.edready.org) for Placement

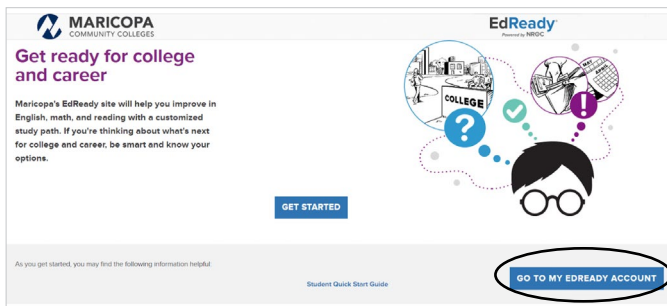
These instructions will help you access the EdReady placement assessments. Be sure to have the following items handy before you begin:

2. Your Maricopa password

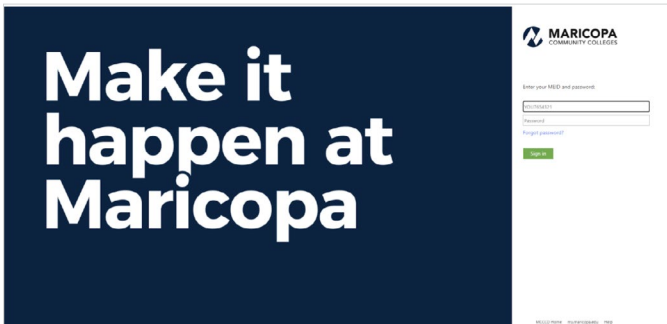

## Getting Started

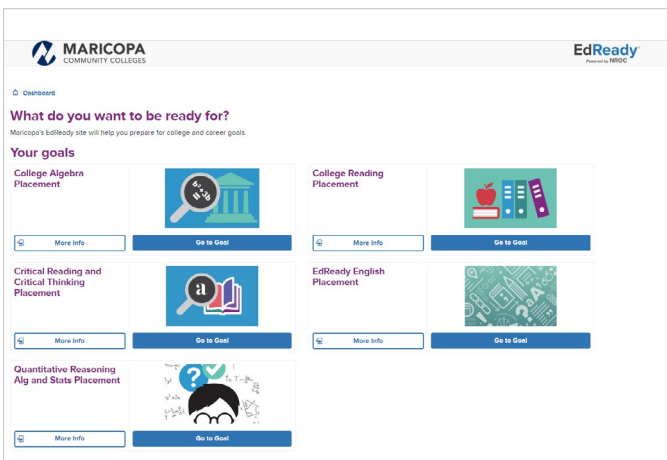
Go to <https://maricopa.edready.org/home> and click on **Go to My EdReady account**.



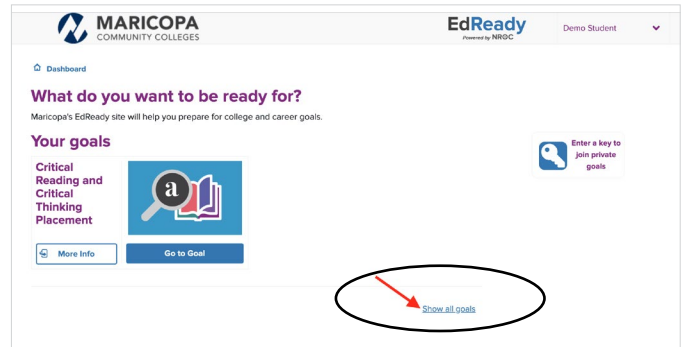
You will be redirected to a Maricopa login page where you can enter your MEID@maricopa.edu and password.



Make sure to approve your login with Duo. Once logged in, you will see the available placement assessments, as shown below.

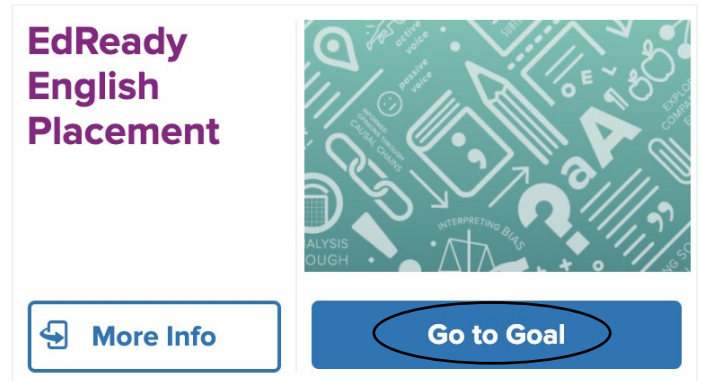


If you don't see the goals above on your homepage, please choose "Show All Goals".

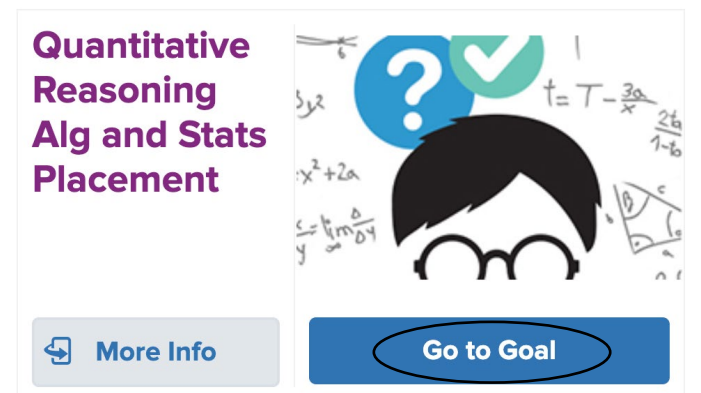


## Choosing Your Goal

To place into **ENG 101**, choose **EdReady English Placement** by clicking the blue **Go to Goal** button. **Minimum score 80 or higher.**



To place into **MAT 142** or **PHY101** choose **Quantitative Reasoning Alg Stats Placement** by clicking the blue **Go to Goal** button. **Minimum score 70 or higher.**



To place into **MAT 152, MAT188\***, **MAT206\***, **MAT212\***, **MAT 221\*** or **PHY111\*** choose **College Algebra Placement** by clicking the blue Go to Goal button. \*Minimum score 80 or higher.

\*Courses require additional placement criteria:

\***MAT188, MAT206 & MAT212** require EdReady College Algebra 80 or higher **WITH** documentation of one of the following: ACT Math 24 or higher OR SAT Math 560 or higher OR HS College Algebra with B or better (submit transcript)

\***MAT221 & PHY111** require EdReady College Algebra 80 or higher **WITH** documentation of one of the following: ACT Math 28 or higher or SAT Math 640 or higher or HS Pre-Calc/Trig with B or better (submit transcript)

To place into or exempt out of **CRE 101**, choose **College Critical Reading and Critical Thinking Placement** by clicking the blue Go to Goal button. **This placement includes:** **ASL101, All ECH/CFS classes, EDU221, EDU282AC, ENH110, POS110, FRE101, & SPA101.** Additional classes may require this placement. Minimum score 90 or higher.

## Completing the Diagnostic

To start the diagnostic, click on the **Start test now** button, and you will be given a series of questions. It will take about one hour to complete the diagnostic.

**College Math Readiness**

The first step of your study path is to complete this initial diagnostic to gain an understanding of your readiness.

Answer the questions as best you can, without study aids, in order to get the most accurate picture of your current understanding.

There is no built-in calculator for EdReady. Some exams (e.g., Accuplacer) allow the use of calculators for some problems, but not others. Use your judgment (or ask your teacher) to decide whether it is appropriate to use a calculator for some or all of this initial diagnostic.

The time of completion will vary. Expect to take at least an hour.

If you need to leave before your initial diagnostic is complete, your work will automatically be saved until your next visit to EdReady.

If you don't know something, be sure to use the **Pass** button. If you aren't sure of a question and want to come back to it, use the **Hold** button. If you need to leave the diagnostic before you finish, click **Save and close**. You will be able to finish at another time.
