

# How to Use maricopa.edready.org for Placement

These instructions will help you access the EdReady placement assessments. Be sure to have the following items handy before you begin:

- 1. Your MEID
- 2. Your Maricopa password

## **Getting Started**


Go to <a href="https://maricopa.edready.org/home">https://maricopa.edready.org/home</a> and click on **Go to My EdReady account**.




You will be redirected to a Maricopa login page where you can enter your MEID@maricopa.edu and password.



Make sure to approve your login with Duo. Once logged in, you will see the available placement assessments, as shown below.




If you don't see the goals above on your homepage, please choose "Show All Goals".




# **Choosing Your Goal**

To place into ENG 101, choose EdReady English Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button. Minimum score 80 or higher.



To place into MAT 142 or PHY101 choose Quantitative Reasoning Alg Stats Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button. Minimum score 70 or higher.




To place into MAT 152, MAT188\*, MAT206\*, MAT212\*, MAT 221\* or PHY111\* choose College Algebra Placement by clicking the blue Go to Goal button. \*Minimum score 80 or higher.




- \*Courses require additional placement criteria:
- \*MAT188, MAT206 & MAT212 require EdReady College Algebra 80 or higher WITH documentation of one of the following: ACT Math 24 or higher OR SAT Math 560 or higher OR Arizona Mathematics Standards – HS Algebra II OR HS College Algebra with B or better (submit transcript)
- \*MAT221 & PHY111 require EdReady College Algebra 80 or higher WITH documentation of one of the following: ACT Math 28 or higher or SAT Math 640 or higher or HS Pre-Calc/Trig with B or better (submit transcript)

New students who are NOT taking a placement assessment listed above and who are under the age of 18 (AR.2.2.2) in grades 9-12 will be required to demonstrate college readiness for the purpose of admissions. Students unable to self-report a unweighted, High School GPA of 2.0 or greater, will take the EdReady College Reading assessment with a recommended score of 75 or higher. This policy will not impact college course placement requirements for individual college course(s).




## **Completing the Diagnostic**

To start the diagnostic, click on the **Start test now** button, and you will be given a series of questions. It will take about one hour to complete the diagnostic.




If you don't know something, be sure to use the **Pass** button. If you aren't sure of a question and want to come back to it, use the **Hold** button. If you need to leave the diagnostic before you finish, click **Save and close**. You will be able to finish at another time.



#### Results

After you complete the diagnostic, you will see a score inside a purple circle on the scorebar. This is the score that will determine in which class you can enroll. Once you obtain the minimum score, you can now submit your Next Steps form. Make sure to follow all the deadlines.



If you do not get the score you need, or you want to increase your score in EdReady, you can work through the study plan provided. Once you obtain the minimum score, you can now submit your Next Steps form. Make sure to follow all the deadlines.
