All students under the age of 18 ([AR.2.2.2](#)) will be required to demonstrate college readiness for the purpose of admissions. This can be accomplished by self-reporting an unweighted, High School GPA of 2.00 or greater. Students unable to self-report a high school GPA of 2.00, will take free EdReady College Reading Placement Goal with a recommended score of 75 or higher.

All classes are contingent on teacher qualifications. Not every college class is available at each high school & subject to change.

College classes listed as yearlong classes register in fall and end in May. College classes that have fall and spring classes that are not yearlong, will register in the fall for both classes. However, students cannot register for a fall term class in the spring term.
