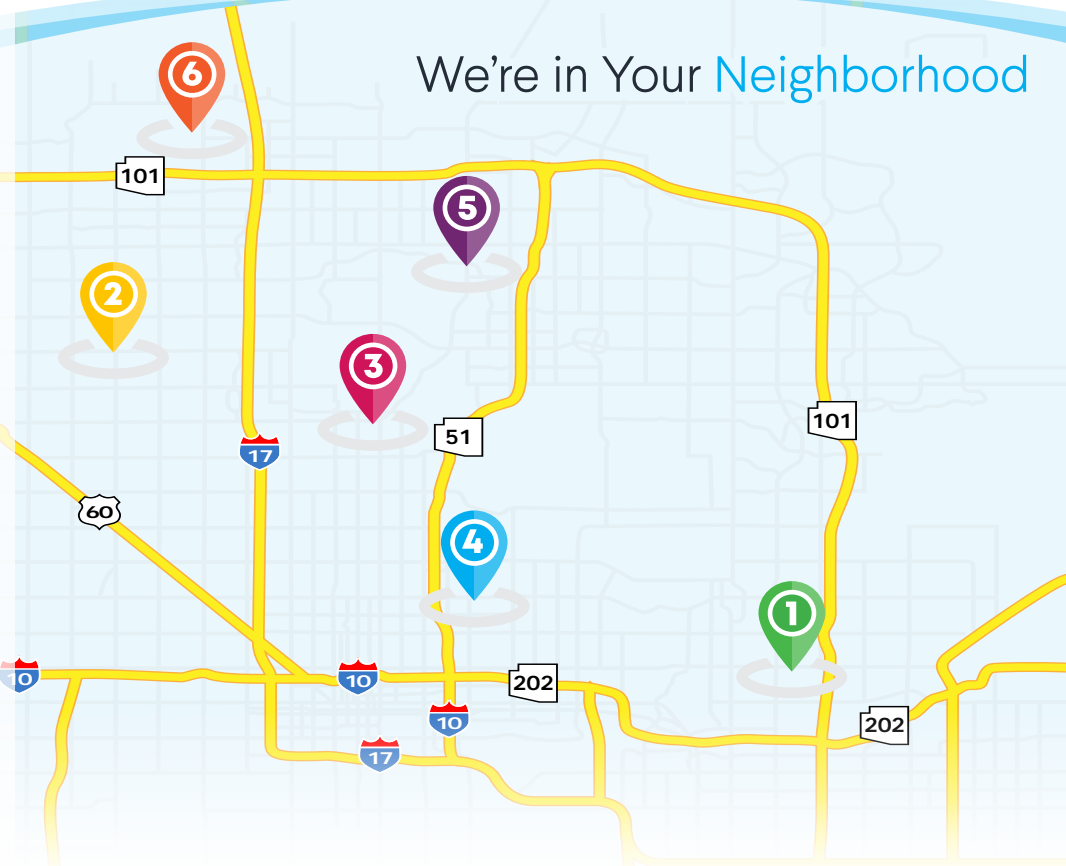

Medical

Doctors, nurse practitioners, and physician associates specializing in family, internal, or general medicine provide primary care to patients of all ages. Medical services include:

Pediatrics

Providers dedicated to working with children ages 0 to 18 offer pediatric services including:

Dental

Nutrition

Counseling

Telehealth / Virtual Appointments

Telehealth connects you with medical, counseling, psychiatry, community resources, and nutrition services remotely using a phone, cellphone, tablet, laptop, or desktop computer.

QuickCare

QuickCare, powered by NOAH, offers virtual appointments with providers for urgent, non-emergency medical and wellness needs. Same-day appointment availability allows patients to access care within hours or even minutes.

NOAH's Patient Portal is a free, easy to use, secure website and mobile app that allows patients to:

- Schedule or cancel appointments
- Review test and lab results
- Make payments
- Request prescription refills
- Send non-urgent medical questions to your Care Team
- Review medications, immunizations, allergies, and health history
