Class Choices After PSY 101



PSY 215: Sports Psychology
Apply psychological perspectives to sport performance.



PSY 250: Social Psychology
Explore how people think about, relate to and influence each other. Learn about self-esteem, love and conflict in close relationships, persuasion tactics and how groups affect us.



PSY 240: Developmental Psychology
Describe and understand human development from conception through adulthood.



PSY 241: Understand & Change Behavior
Experience the theory and methods for observing, analyzing, and modifying behavior as it applies to day-to-day life.



PSY 266: Abnormal Psychology
Explore the continuum between typical mental processes and symptoms of mental illness.



PSY 277: Psychology of Human Sexuality
Learn about sexual anatomy, feelings and behavior associated with sexuality, gender and intersex development, and reproductive health.



PSY 275: Biopsychology
Explore how the brain works, how we study it, and its involvement in both normal and abnormal behavior. (Spring only)



PSY 267: Forensic Psychology
Explore the practice of psychology in the law, by the law, and of the law.



PSY 262: Positive Psychology
The science and art of happiness. How neuroscience, mindfulness, and meditation promotes positive outcomes such as stress reduction, focus, performance, and relationships.



PSY 280: Industrial/Organizational Psychology
Use psychological principals in business settings to enhance understanding of workplace conditions and job performance.
