


How To Connect on Windows 7 PC

Open your wireless connections via the taskbar icon (By default at the bottom right).



1 You may need to open your hidden icons to see your wireless connections icon, as seen in the image below.




Click "Open Network and Sharing Center."


Click "Set up a new connection or network."

Click "Manually connect to a wireless network."




Enter into the following fields:

1	Network name: GauchoNet_Secure
2	Security type: WPA2-Enterprise
3	Encryption type: AES
4	Security Key: leave this field blank


If you wish for the connection to connect automatically when the network is in range, you may tick the box for "Start this connection automatically."

Make sure the "Connect even if the network is not broadcasting" box is unticked.




Click "Change connection settings."


Click the "Security" tab.




Click the "Settings" button.




Untick the "Validate server certificate" box.





Click "OK."




Click "OK."
