## **Enrollment Steps**

Use our Enrollment Steps Guide to track your progress. This guide can help you remember where you left off in the enrollment steps.

The	se are the steps to the Glendale Community College enrollment process:				
1.	Get Admitted - A&R				
	<ul> <li>Complete the admissions application. If you have applied in the past or taken classes at any MCCCD school, please use the <u>Returning Student Application</u>. When filling out the application, select the degree or certificate you plan to pursue.</li> <li>Provide proof of identification during the online application process. If you cannot provide your ID via the admissions application, you can submit it to the Admission and Records department once you have submitted your application.</li> </ul>				
2. Complete Tasks in Student Center- Student					
	<ul> <li>You may have additional tasks to complete after successfully being admitted. To view your tasks, log in to your Student Center.</li> <li>If you are new to GCC, you may need to complete tasks in your Student Center, such as determining course placement or reviewing the New Student Orientation (NSO) presentation, which will be presented through the Student Support HUB on Canvas, and seek initial academic advising.</li> </ul>				
3.	Complete Tasks Specific to Veteran Services Education Benefits:				
	<ul> <li>□ Apply for Benefits online @ <u>VA Education Benefits</u> (Chapters 35,33,31,30, 33TOE)</li> <li>□ Applied to GCC/Get Admitted (In Enrollment Center one time only)</li> <li>□ Get Re-Admitted (If 3 Spring or Fall semesters stopped out)</li> <li>□ Provide copy of Certificate of Eligibility (COE), DD214 copy #4 (Not CH35)</li> <li>□ Request Official copy of Joint Service Transcript GCCAZ campus @ <u>JST Link</u> (Not CH35)</li> <li>□ Request Official transcripts from other institutions of higher learning and forward to GCC</li> <li>□ Placement Testing via <u>EdReady</u> (English, Math &amp; Reading)</li> <li>□ OR Provide High School transcript if finished high school less than 10 yrs &amp; GPA is 2.6+</li> <li>□ Program of Study declared</li> <li>□ Complete advising Intake Form (FOI) <u>Advisement Link</u></li> <li>□ Plans to transfer to a different college or university? If yes,</li></ul>				

	<ul> <li>□ GCC has multiple ways to identify the proper courses for your success. To get started, visit our Placement Guide with this step to find out how to submit placement documents or take online placement assessments.</li> <li>□ If you have taken college-level English, math, or reading courses at a previous college or university, ensure your official transcripts have been sent to Glendale Community College. Based on your previous coursework, placements may have been completed.</li> <li>□ Provide us an unofficial copy, AND have your previous school send your *official transcripts to GCC Arizona. Unofficial Transcripts can be used for temporary course placement and move you to the next step. For more information about Transfer Transcripts, visit this page: https://www.gccaz.edu/admissions/transcripts.</li> <li>□ Submit a VA/Military - Joint Service Transcript (JST) through our Veteran Services Center (VSC) and unofficial copies of previous military education and training transcripts. VSC cannot certify your VA benefits until prior education and training have been evaluated by your VSC Advisor.</li> </ul>			
5. Set Up Initial Academic Advising				
	1. After the completion of admission and the student has obtained their transcripts, academic advising is encouraged. Field of Interest (FOI) Advisors will provide a Suggested Course List and outline an Educational Plan for the degree program, if applicable.			
	2. Connect with an FOI Advisor.			
	Academic Advisement: You will need to complete the Advisement Intake Form to better determine proper advising. Our Prescreening team will then reach out for the next steps.			
	Or Visit the Enrollment Center on campus for in-person assistance connecting with your FOI advisor.			
6.	Register for Classes			
	<ul> <li>Contact VSC Advisors for course selection guidance in agreement with the Education Plan and VA Benefits.</li> <li>Once you know the classes you need to take, use the <a href="How To Register Guide">How To Register Guide</a>; VSC Advisor may assist with enrollment steps.</li> </ul>			
7.	Make Payment Arrangements if needed.			
	<ul> <li>VSC Advisors will begin certification of benefits.</li> <li>You may also apply for Federal financial aid in conjunction with VA education benefits.</li> <li>Determine your grants and/or loan eligibility by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at: <a href="www.fafsa.gov.">www.fafsa.gov.</a></li> </ul>
