Help is available! Try MAT108 – Tutored Mathematics!

MAT108 is structured class time to help with your current math class led by a math faculty member and assisted by tutors to help with homework, to answer questions and get you ready for exams. Beyond helping with your current class you'll learn math study skills that you can apply to future math classes. The class meets twice a week for 50 minutes and will cater instruction to your current math topics. Classes eligible for Tutored Mathematics are MAT081 through MAT151. If you have a higher level math class, you may be able to obtain special permission to enroll. Please ask your instructor for more information.

For military veterans, our partner agency S.E.E.4Vets has provided scholarship funds to cover the cost of tuition and fees for MAT108. MAT108 is not covered by the GI Bill, so please stop by the Veterans Service Center to learn more and complete an application for the Math Success Scholarship. In addition, if you've already started a class and you feel you need some extra help, you may enroll in the class up until the end of the second week into the semester provided seats are available.

As an added bonus, if you attend MAT108 and complete the concurrent math class with a grade of B or higher, you will be entered into a drawing for a \$100 gift card for the Campus Bookstore.

If you have struggled with math in the past or math makes you uncomfortable, give MAT108 a try! With scholarships available, personalized tutoring and the chance to win a \$100 gift card, the only thing you have to lose is your math anxiety!

The SEE4VETS Math Success Scholarship is an academic initiative designed to assist military affiliated students enrolled in MAT08X, 09X or college level math toward degree completion. Data shows that those students enrolled in MAT108 - concurrently with their regular math course, achieve greater academic success. The current GI Bill[®] does not provide funding for MAT108. Student veterans selected for this scholarship will have the full tuition for the course and course fee(s) covered by the scholarship at the in state tuition rate. Students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a new or continuing military affiliated student to Glendale Community College
- Be enrolled a minimum of half-time (at least 6 credit hours)
- Be enrolled in a developmental (MAT 08X or MAT 09X) or college level math course through to MAT 151.
- Student veterans must be enrolled and attending a MAT108 no later than the second week of instruction.
- Student veterans must complete an application and be interviewed by an advisor assigned to the Veterans Service Center at Glendale Community College.
- For continuing awards of this scholarship, a student must successfully complete MAT108 and achieve a grade of B or higher in the current math class.

ALL QUESTIONS MUST BE ANSWERED for this application to be processed. Completed applications must be submitted EACH SEMESTER you are requesting the scholarship. Notification of award or denial will be emailed to you after an eligibility evaluation.
